THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ALBION-LITTLE RIVER FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT PROPOSES TO CHANGE THE UNIFORM SCHEDULES AND RATES FOR A SPECIAL FIRE AND RESCUE TAX

WHEREAS, at its Special Meeting on Thursday, July 11, 2024 the Board of Directors of the Albion-Little River Fire Protection District shall consider adoption of Revised Ordinance 05-15-24

WHEREAS, this Board pursuant to Section 53978 of the California Government Code, on behalf of the District adopts an ordinance imposing a special tax increase to be used to maintain and improve the current level of fire protection, prevention, suppression, emergency medical, hazardous materials response, search, and rescue services. In addition, the increase will be directed toward procurement, equipping, operating, and maintaining equipment and infrastructure, training personnel, and for the purpose of paying salaries of personnel or any related services; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance adopted by the Board, must, by law, be submitted to the qualified voters of the District, whose approval by a two-thirds vote of those casting ballots is required if the tax is to become effective; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albion-Little River Fire Protection District calls for a special election to be held on November 5, 2024, and further requests the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors to consolidate said election with other elections on that same day; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appropriations limit for the District shall be increased by the amount of the tax money raised by the imposition of this tax; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the question placed before the voters reads as follows:

Shall the Albion-Little River Fire Protection District, by Ordinance, (1) Repeal the existing special tax of \$75.00 per unit, (2) Replacing it with a special tax of \$300.00 per unit, increasing 2% annually; this special tax shall be used for: maintaining and improving fire protection, suppression, prevention, medical, and rescue activities; maintaining and procuring equipment, apparatus, and infrastructure; and paying for personnel training and salaries; (3) Adjust appropriations based on increased revenue from the tax?
